- Please *all* put items in order of preference with the one you most want to be in the

exhibition first. Whether items are included may depend on the size and type of item as well as the quantity.

- All entries must contain an element of hand spinning, weaving or dying
- The inclusion of more than 3 items per member is at the discretion of the exhibition committee.
- The novice section is for anyone who is a less experienced spinner. This is not based on the number of years you have been spinning but how experienced and confident you are.
- The novice section is self selected and aims to give members confidence to submit their work. It is also important that visitors see work at different levels as they can otherwise be put off from joining the Guild and learning to spin.
- You don't need to put all of your items in the novice section if you don't want to.
- Forms must be with Janet by **Friday 9th March** or they will not be included in the catalogue and will not have a label in the exhibition. The timescale is important as it is a big job to make up the catalogue and labels, and changing it later is complicated. The people volunteering to set up the exhibition set aside time to do these tasks and are not always able to do things at a later date.
- Make sure you have made arrangements to have your items taken to and picked up from the exhibition if you are not able to do this yourself.
- Items can normally be brought to the last Guild meeting before the exhibition if you cannot take them to Gracefield at the appointed time.
- Someone is normally able to take items away afterwards and similarly bring them to the next Guild meeting *but this needs to be arranged so that they know to do it.*
- *Items for sale at £20 or over will have a 40% commission deducted by Gracefield. Items less than £20 have no commission charge.*

Please list any items you are able to lend to assist with displaying our work.

All exhibition, display items and packaging must be clearly marked with your name.
